

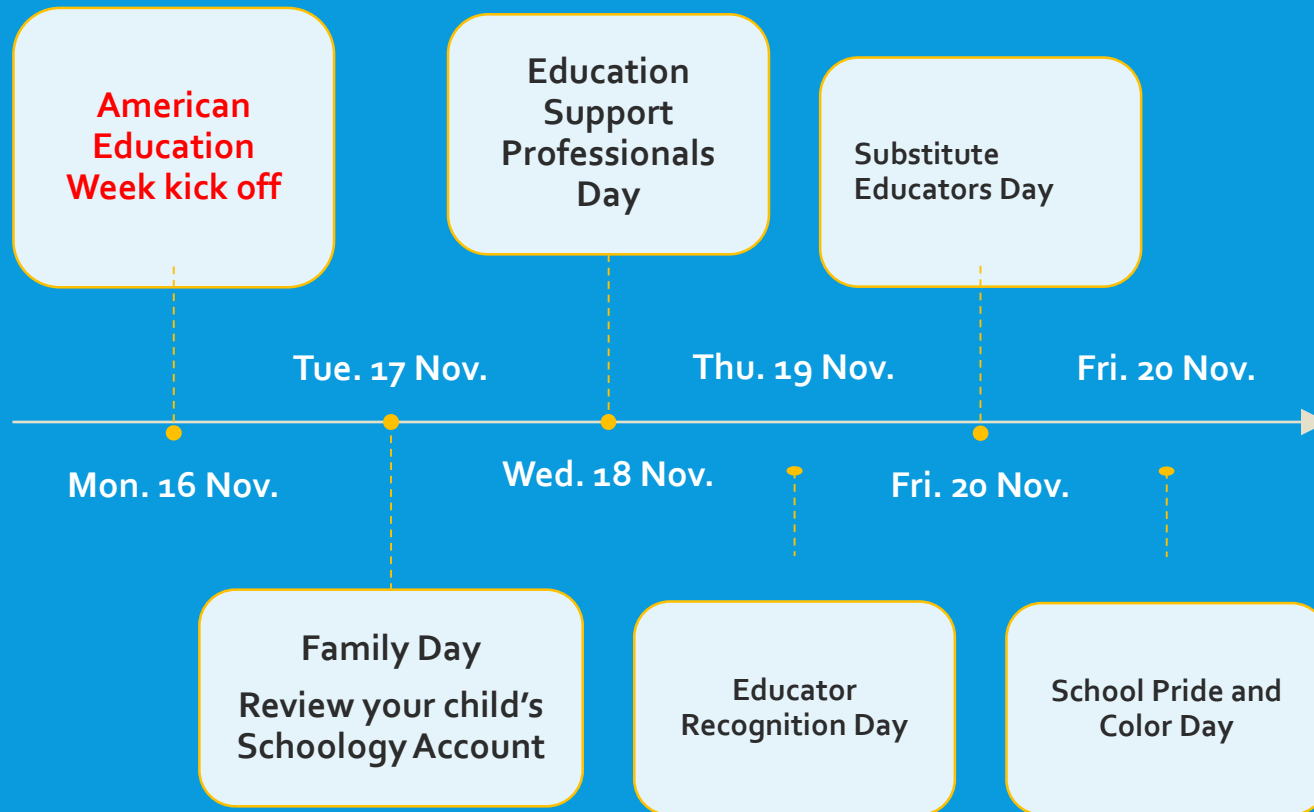

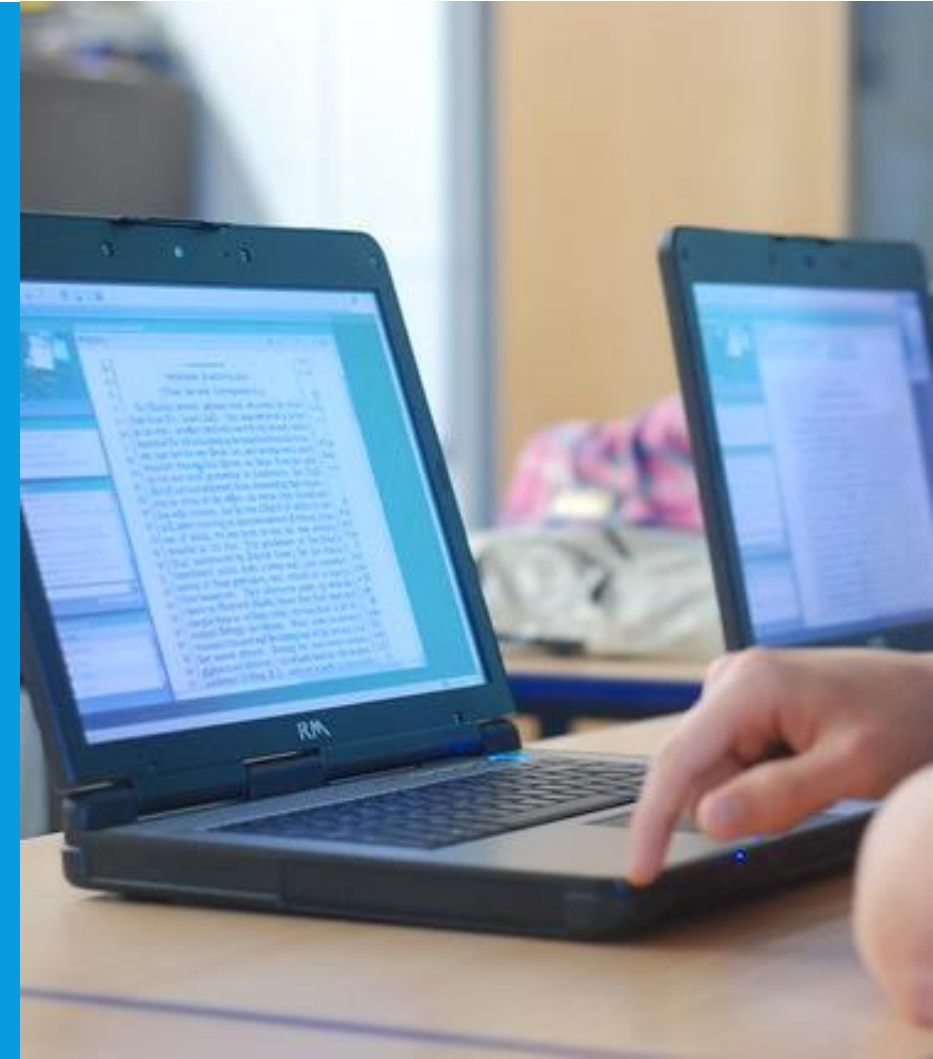

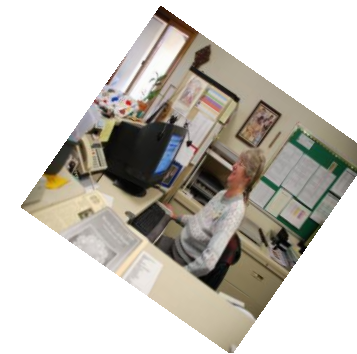
BCPS will celebrate two national observances during the week:
