Fundamentals of Art

All students interested in the advanced art course must take Fundamentals of Art as a pre-requisite. This course fulfills the graduation requirement for the state of Maryland. GT is offered based on portfolio production during the year or recommendation from middle school.

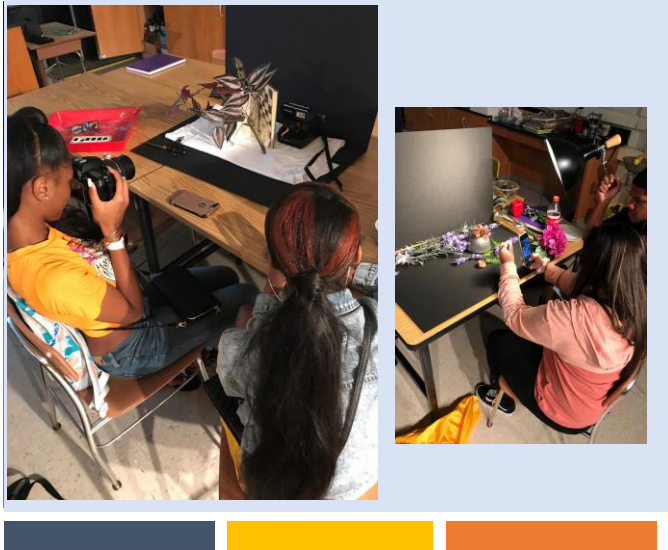

Clay and Mixed Media Mr. Gordon

Through hand building and throwing on the wheel, Mr. Gordon develops skill and personal exploration in three-dimensional media and ceramic arts. Student's will complete designs and ideas using professional materials and processes in clay and other materials. Opportunity for advanced clay courses and AP 3-D Studio portfolio application are available.

Photography Mrs. Stokes

Photography Studio is a full year elective course. Students experience photography as a Fine Art with a focus on Black & White photographs, as well as digital directions and Photoshop. Students will learn to use a manual camera, develop film, and work in the darkroom to make black and white prints.

Advanced Photography Studio is a full year, advanced elective course. Students extend their knowledge and experience photography as a Fine Art. Students will use both traditional darkroom and digital techniques to explore the ways photography can communicate, document, and solve visual problems. This course may be taken for AP credit.



Digital Arts Mr. Gordon

Students in Digital arts will explore the Adobe Creative Cloud with a focus in Photoshop, Illustrator and Premiere. While building life-long skills for our digital age, students will develop a portfolio of digital imagery showcasing graphic design and multimedia skills.
